Topic: Spirited Away

For the visual aesthetic, we agreed to have a combination of the main page having a black background and bright imagery/text that is reminiscent of lights/lanterns at night outside of the bath house, and pages that reflect the interior of the bath house such as the pale green of the walls, as if entering the pages from the main page is like going inside of the bath house.



Both Katie and I agreed to have the site contents include a production page, plot page, and a cast page, as well as possibly having a short biography/information page about the maker, Miyazaki. The links to the pages are to be displayed at the top of the page in a horizontal bar. The main page of the site will show images from the movie with a brief synopsis similar to the back of a DVD, and then allow the user to enter the site through links to the various subpages. The production page will be divided into sections similar to the Wikipedia page. The plot page will give a detailed overview of the film and also discuss the themes and references afterwards,

and the link leading to the plot page will be preceded by a “spoiler warning” page that showcases the following clickable image with text that will then be able to click through to the actual content.



The cast page will display images of each of the characters in a vignette format (transparent background with the character only) rather than the actors, and list the information for both the Japanese and English cast. The Miyazaki page will give some background information on his life and discuss his work. All the pages will display rich imagery from the animation.

Throughout the site, there may also be appearances of these little characters as decorative elements or navigational elements leading back to the main page/to the top of the page etc.
