
Designer: Katie Jundt Topic: Spirited Away

### Typeface:

- Try changing the Papyrus typeface: It works okay for the title Spirited Away, but at least use it more sparingly by using a different typeface in the body and probably for the menu items as well
- Make the text on the cast page not oblique
- Increase leading in body text, and try making text a little thinner overall

#### Main Page:

- Make the title bigger and not in the corner for the main page, something that goes across the page more?
- May not even need the synopsis text, especially if the main page is a photo gallery
- If the main page scrolls through images, consider adding some buttons like the little circles showing which image you are on, or maybe an Enter Site button.



 This kind of thing, but in a more aesthetically pleasing manner (smaller circles that kind of glow? Kind of mimicking that lantern feeling? Probably no arrows)

# Subpages:

- Highlight the menu item you are on when on a subpage
- Maybe give a heading to each subpage before the body text (You can try doing either 1 of these two, or both but may not need both)
- Spoiler Page:
  - Redesign the type- the "SPOILERS" part looks okay but the "THE PAGE...." Part looks somewhat off.
  - The continue and return text also look a little too small and thin as a line of text to float over the image, so maybe give them a button frame of some sort.
- Miyazaki Page:
  - Include imagery from his other films somehow (can be hyperlinked from the text?)

#### Imagery:

- Include more images from the movie
- Either in a "Gallery" subpage or have the main page be a scroll through slideshow (I like this idea)
- Can also have hyperlinks in the text that lead to images?
- Imagery of the first page is a different aesthetic than rest of the site, so maybe include more of that kind of majestic/beautiful imagery throughout the site
