

## Responsive?

- Homepage: try making it expand from the left side, so that the picture cards don't get cut off when you stretch the width

## General Notes:

- The typeface that you found is AWESOME. My only problems with it are that it is all in italics. While that makes it look more handwritten (which I LOVE), it also makes it difficult to read.
  - It is perfect to the navigation bar and index page, but is there a more mild/gentle typeface that we can use for the body?

## History:

- Make the title in the box match the bold face of the navigation bar button
- Can the history box sit a bit lower so that it is at the same y-axis height as the box on the characteristics page?
- Make the box larger? Right now it is visually confusing because of where the text cuts off. If more of the text was available initially then the scroll aspect would be more apparent
  - I also think that it is okay to break the "cards" aesthetic here because a card wouldn't actually scroll anyway, so having it be like an actual "scroll" of historical info would be thematic as well

## Characteristics:

- The drop shadow on the text box is odd. I didn't notice it as much on the other pages (are they even on the other pages? #TooLazyToGoCheck) but maybe because it is on a lighter background it stands out.
  - Try making it a grey tone, or something darker so that it really stands out as a drop shadow, or just scrap it entirely
- I am more okay with the scrolling on this page in relation to the text box. Perhaps the problem is where the bolded text on the History page cuts off. It's up to you, if we can make it so that the text fits better in the box then I am all for leaving the boxes at this index card shape/size. Otherwise I think the easy solution would be to make them longer.
  - By longer, I don't mean long enough so that the whole page scrolls. But maybe just an inch or two longer so that they just show more text.

## Critters:

- Photoshop the names off of the images (they are at the bottom)
- Some of the images have a box around the scene within the image. If you can Photoshop out that box then the whole thing will be much cleaner.
- I LOVE the hover box for each critter, but I wonder if there is a Fearsome Critters wiki page, like one for each critter? If so, making the image for each critter clickable so that it just links to that external website would really be glorious.
  - I know that this is a lot to ask, but it would just be the coolest thing.
